



Rules for Carrying a Concealed Handgun

1. You must notify the sheriff issuing the permit of any change of address within thirty (30) days of the change.
2. You may not carry a concealed handgun while consuming or after having consumed alcohol or other controlled substance which alters judgment or physical control.
3. Handgun may be concealed in purse or pocket.
4. Permit and a valid North Carolina issued picture ID must be on your person when carrying a concealed handgun.
5. You must tell any approaching law enforcement officer that you are carrying a concealed handgun.
6. Failure to carry permit or to notify approaching law enforcement officer is an infraction for the first offense, a misdemeanor in subsequent instances.
7. Permits can be revoked for lying on application, lending your permit to another person or being charged with a crime.
